He stated (see below):</p> <p>"Please stop sending these emails to all and sundry.</p> <p>One of your lawyers must have told you at some point that as "Britain's largest ever female fraudster" and let's face it £15 million is quite a lot your chances of rebutting the proposition that your deportation is conducive to the public good is zero.</p> <p>If no one has told you that I'm telling you that now.</p> <p>It also seems to be the case that none of your caseworkers at the Home Office speaks even basic French because if they did they would notice that the Mauritian press even names the school you went to in Mauritius and comments how well known you are in Mauritian circles</p> <p>Just stop sharing this. Just deal with your lawyers."</p>



Considering that I have never dealt with Migrant Law Partnership Solicitors, I find it unacceptable that a solicitor, especially one specialising in immigration law, would chastise and patronise me and further allege that my case and campaign are bound to be unsuccessful.

His message is both highly unprofessional and deeply distressing. If he doubts the details of my story or is sceptical of my campaign, he could have asked for further evidence to be provided or to be removed from the mailing list. Instead he decided to send the email above which he not only sent to me but to the other members of the mailing list so as to further humiliate me. Though I am unsure of his exact motive, this email has caused severe emotional damage to myself and to my relatives as well as jeopardising my credibility and thus also my campaign.

I believe that Solicitors have the duty to adhere to the mandatory SRA principles. Mr Bartram's actions reveal a total disrespect for those principles. Equally, as an immigration lawyer he ought to treat those in vulnerable circumstances such as myself with much greater levels of respect. He ought also to recognise the complexity of immigration cases and not to accept things as they first appear, as he has done with me.

I have been utterly humiliated by Mr Bartram for no apparent reason and I would urge the SRA to please conduct an enquiry regarding the above. Thank you.
